## **Product code: PRE100**



Prevasse is an aid in the prevention of pressure ulceration for all patients including those assessed as high risk, and for the treatment of existing stage 1 and 2 pressure ulcers. Clinical supervision is advised if damage is severe. Prevasse may be cleaned and reused for multiple patient use.

This cushion is pre-inflated and ready to use

Position cushion with strap at rear and arrow pointing forwards. Secure around the back of the chair.

If required, Prevasse may be topped up by hand with the pump provided by following the 3 steps below:

- Insert the pump nozzle firmly into the cushion valve
- Inflate with *just* enough air to ensure the patient is 'floating' on the air cushion, by adding a small amount of air at a time. DO NOT OVER INFLATE.
- Close the valve when finished and invert valve into cushion so as to be out of the way

Check device regularly to ensure proper inflation level. It may be necessary to add or remove air for just the right comfort level, but always ensure the patient is fully supported on the cushion. If deterioration in skin condition is noted, cease use and seek clinical advice.





## **Precautions**

Keep away from sharp objects, pets, babies and small children, and avoid sources of heat (including lighted cigarettes). Product does not contain latex.

Please note, Prevasse is not suitable for the following:

- Persons weighing in excess of 139kg
- Persons with unstable spinal fracture
- Where body shape is such that the person cannot be fully supported by the cushion

## Cleaning instructions

Cover can be machine washed at 60°C. Cushion may be cleaned using lukewarm water and soap or detergent only. Disinfect in accordance with local policy for standard mattresses but do not use phenol or alcohol based disinfectants as these may compromise the device. Always rinse well with fresh water after cleaning, and always allow to air-dry at room temperature prior to reuse or storage.

Do not dry clean tumble dry or iron
